FORMAT

The first game of the tournament will be drawn at random. From round 2 onwards the tournament will use the Swiss format and all teams will regenerate after each game.

the tier breakers will be:

1. Total score
2. Strength of schedule
3. Net TD+Net Cas (only SPP generating casualties are counted)

In case of a tie between all tiebreakers a coin will be flipped to decide.

Scoring for the tournament is as follows

- 20pts for a win
- 10pts for a draw
- 0pts for a loss
- -50 for a concede

TEAM BUILDING

Rosters are built using a treasury allowance of 1,150,000 gold crowns. Unspent treasury is lost and there is no reward for lower TV teams in the pre-match sequence. The inducements a team may take include:

- Bloodweiser kegs (max 2)
- Biased referee (max 1)
- Bribes (max 1)
- Halfling master chef (max 1)
- Rituous rookies (max 1)

Notes-

- The disposable skill is NOT in use when calculating TV.
- If rituous rookies are taken these are to be rolled at the beginning of each game and rookie models should be marked clearly.

STAR PLAYERS

Star players are available to all teams. Please see the skill list for the skill allowance including a star as taking stars will cost the team a certain amount of their skill allocation in addition to their normal cost.

When rostering a star player please follow the following rules:

- You **must** first roster 11 players on the team before adding a star
- 0-1 star players may be taken on a team from tier 1-2
- 0-2 star players may be taken on a team from tier 3-4
- Stars that include two models (e.g Dribl and drull) count as two star players
- If players are drawn against another player using the same star both are permitted to use it.
- Stars cannot be given additional skills
